

Gifted & Talented Stipend – Elementary Schools

A \$500 stipend is available to all elementary schools to support and promote gifted and talented instruction and/or gifted and talented special programs.

Stipend Guidelines

- All purchases must directly relate to curriculum-based enrichment and/or to GT Special Programs.
- Funds can be used for resources and materials, guest speakers, rewards and ribbons, bussing to competition events, etc.
- Schools should track student growth in relation to the instruction or program. Sample pre/post tests and other simple assessments will be provided upon request.
- A minimum of three teachers should participate in the enrichment and/or GT Special Program.
- Schools will pay for the items, then send an NPO to the GT Department for reimbursement.
- Only \$500 will be reimbursed. If your expenditures exceed \$500, we will reimburse \$500 and the school will be responsible for the remaining amount.
- Principals can submit the application through April 1, 2018.
- Please submit requests for reimbursement by June 1, 2018.

We hope all schools will find use for the GT stipend this year.
