



## **Arts Education (AE) grants for the 2016-2017 school year are available online. Past applicants are welcome to apply.**

The following grants are available for an in-depth, fine arts standards-based experience that engages students and classroom teacher(s) in quality arts instruction:

### **Arts Education Artist-In-Residence Grant (Due MARCH 18):**

Funding for first-time and returning applicants (school/school districts) to provide one artist in the discipline of the applicant's choice for a minimum of a 40-hour residency.

### **Arts Education Project Grant (Due MARCH 18):**

Intended for schools or school districts that have previously received funding from Utah Arts & Museums. Funds may be used for one or more artists working in a school and may also include multi-disciplinary projects.

### **Teacher Initiated Project Grants (Open Year-Round):**

Financial assistance for teachers and administrators to gain knowledge and skills in an artistic discipline of their choice.
