How does BOB work?

Students interested in representing your school will fill out an application from the PTA. There are requirements listed, but most any high school student can organize a band to participate. They will need a cover song & an original song.

*If more than one band applies, they will need an opportunity to play in front of the student body so your students can vote on who to send to represent your school. This can be done by letting them perform in the cafeteria during lunch, during an assembly at school, or in the evening with parents and students invited.

Once your band has been chosen, they will work with the PTA President to submit their paperwork and CD to Region. This is due March 1st.

*If only one band applies, they are automatically your school's representatives. It is nice if they have the chance to perform their two songs during lunch or an assembly so students know who is representing them. It also gives them the chance to be in front of an audience, which is helpful.

Last year we hosted high schools from Jordan, Granite, and Tooele in our Multi-Region BOB Competition (thank you Todd Quarnberg and CHHS for letting us use your school). This year Granite is hosting. We had **four times** more fans last year than the previous year. Students & parents LOVED it! We would like to see this fantastic program continue to grow as we will be hosting again next year. This year's competition will be held:

First, second, and third place, and the People's Choice winner, will receive a cash prize. The top 3 bands will compete in State Battle of the Bands at the SLCC Grand Theatre on April 29th. The winning band will receive cash, professional music training, and studio recording time.

Please work with your PTA President to decide how you'd like to spread the word. We want our students to know about this. If it could be in your morning announcements, appear on your marquee, and if applications could be picked up from the office, we would really appreciate it. There will be posters available soon, as well.
