Turnaround Scholarship Selection Criteria: *Please include in your submission noteworthy interactions with teachers, advisors, counselors and administrators as well as the extent of need.*

1. Personal Circumstances

Has suffered a significant personal hardship (ie: a tough personal or family circumstance which may have created a period of poor academic performance, poor attitude, etc.)

2. Marked Improvement

Has shown marked improvement in grades, school performance and personal life and is in good standing in the school and community.

3. Commitment to Education

Has made a commitment to continue their education beyond high school and attend a college, university or trade/skill school.

4. Financial Assistance

Deserves but has no other chance of obtaining any other type of scholarship.

Please submit by MARCH 13, 2020. One senior student from each high school will be honored at the JEF annual Awards Recognition Banquet to be held on April 16, 2020 at the Embassy Suites in South Jordan.
