School Level Math Olympiad

What

Math Club: A group of students meeting to solve non-typical math problems in a fun filled atmosphere.

Who

Any 7th and 8th grade student who would like to participate.

Where

2 Choices:

- Once a week after school (\$1200 stipend)
- Once a week during advisory with contests after school (\$400 stipend)

When

Club begins as soon as possible.

School level competitions are held once a month from Nov - Mar.

Costs

\$150 to register a club. Paid by the Gifted and Talented department in Teaching and Learning! Registration includes a score database for 35 students, a club packet and a resource book.

Of note: More than 35 students can participate each week, but only the top 35 scores are recorded into the database.

Jordan District MS Math Tournament

What

A geographically-defined area competition, hosted by Jordan School District.

Who

Each school may bring up to three teams of 7th and 8th graders to the competition. Each team is composed of 5 students. Students will compete individually and as a team.

Where

South Jordan Middle School

When

Saturday, April 29th 8:30 a.m. - 12:00 noon

Tournament length is dependent upon competition needs. If tie breakers are needed the competition may take longer.

Other Requirements

Schools must bring two-to-three volunteers to the tournament. One of the volunteers should be the coach. The volunteers will proctor, score, and monitor student teams.
