SUBJECT: 2022 RISE Summative Test Administration Training and Resources

The RISE assessment is a computer adaptive criterion referenced assessment system that includes summative tests for English Language Arts (ELAs), Mathematics, Science, and Writing. The summative tests are scheduled to be delivered to the following elementary grades.

English Language Arts: 3-6
Mathematics: 3-6
Science: 4-6
Writing: 5

School administrators are encouraged to pass the following information on to their RISE-tested teachers.

The RISE assessment window will be open from March 28, 2022 until May 27, 2022. Many teachers only use the RISE system once a year, and so need a yearly training on how it all works. Only teachers who will administer the test need to be trained. The following teacher training webinars are already scheduled.
