School Level Math Olympiad

What

Math Club: A group of students meeting to solve non-typical math problems in a fun filled atmosphere.

Who

Any 7th and 8th grade student who would like to participate.

Where

2 Choices:

- Once a week after school (\$1200 stipend)
- During advisory time (at least once a week) with contests after school (\$400 stipend)

When

Club begins as soon as possible. The four school level competitions are from November - March.

Costs

\$200 to register a club by October 15th. Paid by the Gifted and Talented Department in Teaching and Learning! Registration includes a score database for 35 students and a club packet. Schools that have not participated in previous years will receive a resource book, as well.

Of note: More than 35 students can participate each week, but only the top 35 scores are recorded into the MOEMS database.

Jordan District MS Math Tournament

What

A geographically-defined area competition, hosted by Jordan School District.

Who

Each school may bring up to three teams of 7th and 8th grader students to the competition. Each team is composed of 5 students. Students will compete both individually and as a team.

Where

Jordan School District Auxiliary Services Building Auditorium, Entrance A.

When

Monday, May 6th 8:30 a.m. - 12:00 noon (Subs provided.)
Tournament length is dependent upon competition needs. If tie breakers are needed the competition may take longer.

Other Requirements

Schools must bring 1-2 adults to the tournament, in addition to the math club coach. The adults will proctor, score, and monitor student teams. The adults can be other teachers or parent volunteers.
