

## Important Information for 7th Grade Mathematics Registration

Dear Principals, Counselors, Department Chairs, and 6th Grade Teachers,

As we approach middle school registrations for the 2025-26 school year, please note changes to the math class enrollment process. Options vary, so consult with school administrators and counselors, as not all schools offer every choice.

### Registration Process for This Year:

- **Regular or Honors Mathematics:** Students and parents can choose either option without additional requirements or testing, per [R277-728](#). Note that not all schools provide honors courses.
- **Accelerated Courses:** 7th and 8th grade accelerated courses require students to be proficient on RISE 6th Grade Assessment. Availability varies by school.
- **Progress Directly to 8th Grade Mathematics:** Students can opt to move directly to 8th grade by:
  - Scoring 80% or higher on a 7th-grade standard competency exam.

\*Note: Not all schools offer Secondary II at the middle school level; students may need to attend high school or take an online course. Parents are responsible for transportation.

However, it is fast-paced and goes into greater depth with the content.  <b>*Not all schools offer or need to offer this option.</b></p> <p><i>This course is recommended for 10-20% of the population.</i></p>	<p><b>This course is recommended for students who are motivated and score proficient on RISE with a score of 3 or 4.</b></p> <p>Students will complete an accelerated course that will allow them to complete 2 years of mathematics (7th and 8th grade) in 1 year. The content will be integrated for flow, depth, and rigor.  <b>*Not all schools offer or need to offer this option.</b></p> <p><i>This course is recommended for 5-15% of the population.</i></p>	<p><b>This course is recommended for students who are highly motivated and proficient in 6th-grade standards.</b></p> <p>Students will demonstrate competency in 7th-grade standards before enrollment.</p> <p><b>COMPETENCY can be demonstrated by passing a competency exam</b></p> <p><i>This course is recommended for 1%-3% of the population.</i></p>
