In order to provide these experiences, students need to be in attendance more than 90% of the time. As of April 2025, 26% of the district's student body is chronically absent (missing 10% or more of school). TRUANCY MEDIATION

"Truancy mediation is a school-based restorative justice intervention for students and families struggling with regular school attendance." It is program run by the Juvenile Justice Court for students in grades 7-12 that uses the presence and skills of a neutral third party (mediator) to help resolve the attendance problem in a safe environment.








PANORAMA GUIDANCE FOR ADDRESSING ATTENDANCE


