

AVOID • DENY • DEFEND DRILL PROTOCOL

Instructions for Administrators

- Step 1. Contact your School Resource/DARE Officer. Know them and their cell number.
- Step 2. Review the Incident Command Violence Incident Action Plan and Avoid Deny Defend (ADD) strategies with the School Safety Committee/Incident Command Team.
- Step 3. With input from the School Safety Committee/Incident Command Team and officer, plan discussions, practices and/or drills to be held. Examples include, but are not limited to:
 - a) Conduct a meeting to discuss drill protocol
 - b) Conduct a table top scenario exercise with officer participation
 - c) Conduct a building walk through with the staff and officer, to perform a “what if and then” exercise using the ADD strategies listed below.
- Step 4. Continue to conduct Incident Command drills as usual, and implement the ADD strategies as discussed and planned with the officer.
- Step 5. Conduct a debrief meeting after drills, to make improvements.
- Step 6. Continue to report meetings, exercises and drills using the online forms on the Google Drive.
- Step 7. In high schools ONLY, for now, provide opportunities for students to view the JSD Avoid Deny Defend video.
