The Botvin LifeSkills Training Program is currently the only approved program to meet the requirements as outlined in <u>UCA § 53G-10-406</u> and <u>R277-910</u>.

The Botvin LifeSkills Training program must be offered to all students in **grades 4 AND 8, AND 10** (UCA § 53G-10-406).

Teachers only have to complete this training one time. If they have already completed it in past years, they do not need to do it again.
