

SUBJECT: CSTAG Updates January 2024

Please be aware of the following updates regarding Comprehensive School Threat Assessment (CSTAG) in Jordan District.

- **Comprehensive School Threat Assessment Manual** (see image)
 - Each school in JSD should have at least 1(one) CSTAG manual to access and share amongst your threat assessment team. If you do not, please contact Angie Rasmussen at angie.rasmussen@jordandistrict.org to request one. The cost is \$55.
- **Upcoming trainings**
 - Just a reminder that the next CSTAG Level 2 training is on March 1, 2024.
 - This training will cover how to use CSTAG in your school and everyday threat assessment practices.

 - There is either a morning or afternoon session.
 - Due to conflicting events, the June 5th training for CSTAG Level 3 is has been rescheduled to **8-10am on June 12th** in room 129 at the District Office.
- **School Safety Specialists should be trained in CSTAG Level 1**
 - Just a reminder to email Angie or Travis Hamblin to request this training.
 - We register them via Navigate 360 and the school is billed for this asynchronous, virtual course. The cost of the course is \$85 per person.
 - Navigate 360 then sends the participant an email with instructions on how to log in and get started with the course.
