Team Captains

- Team Captains who sign up before March 31st can use the coupon code teacher2022 to register for free.
- The first 50 teachers to create a Team with at least 5 runners (of any age) are entered into a prize drawing.
- Team Captains who actively participate with (at least 5 team members) will receive some level of a grant.
- Team Captains who create a team with at least 25 participants who may comprise students, parents, family members, friends, etc., are guaranteed at least a \$250 grant.
- Based on a percentage of overall enrollment, the school with the highest participation will be awarded a \$2500 grant.
- If your students have parents, grandparents or other interested parties who wish to support your classroom but do not want to participate in the race, we encourage you to setup a fundraising page and invite them to make a donation. Funds donated from these sources will be given directly to the Team Captain in the form of a grant.
- Each teacher who creates a team will receive **FREE** teeth whitening from Genesis Dental.

Registration

- After completing the personal and waiver information, you are now ready to create your team from the link "Create New Race Group"). In identifying your team, we ask that you preface your team name with the name of your school. For example, Herriman Elementary Warriors or Bingham High Racers. Following this protocol will assist us in the management of this activity.
- Where indicated, **Do Not set race a group password**. This will make it hard for others to sign up on your team.
- The default options will create a fundraiser with the same name as your team. Be sure to set a goal amount and put something specific as to how you will use the donations. This will enhance greater donor participation.
- Each participant will receive a t-shirt. When you register and create your team, you will be asked for t-shirt sizes for each participant.
- Running the day of the race is not required. Most team captains typically run, but it is not mandatory. Your decision to participate or not participate will not influence your earning a grant.
- When an individual signs up on your team, it means you're getting credit for their participation in The Challenge Obstacle Run. It does not mean you are responsible for transportation or keeping track of your team members during the race. Also, team members are not grouped together, nor will they be required to run together.

We're so excited for your participation in this year's Challenge Obstacle Run! In 2019 we had 1,218 participants and we are anticipating well over 1,500 this year.
