Common Sense Media is one of the major providers of digital citizenship training in the United States. They provide high-quality digital literacy and citizenship programs. That teacher leader will then promote the program within the school community by leading a team of teachers through certification. This program is funded by the Digital Teaching and Learning Grant.

Requirements

Common Sense Educator Teacher Leader

- Teacher Leader completes training
 - o Enroll in Canvas course
 - o JPLS Course Number: 101349
 - Attend District lead face-to-face session
 - Date of face-to-face: October 22
 - Complete all course requirements
- In collaboration with school administration, teacher leader recruits and guides a team of 5-10 teachers through Common Sense Educator certification

Team of Common Sense Educators

- Teachers enroll in school level course
 - o Enroll in Canvas course
 - JPLS Course Number:TBD
 - Attend school-led face-to-face session
 - o Complete all course requirements
- Teachers complete course requirements under direction of school teacher leader to become Common Sense Educators

Incentives

- Each Common Sense Educator Teacher Leader (1 per school) will receive **\$500** when they complete the course
- Participating Common Sense Educator (5-10 per school) will receive \$100 when they complete the course
