□ Make sure you have an active and accurate educator portal account <u>https://educator.kiteaai.org</u>.

□ Complete annual security agreement in Educator Portal.

□ Make sure teacher role is "teacher" in Educator Portal, upper right hand corner.

□ Complete and pass quizzes with at least 80%. (Completed in Moodle – instructions on back).

□ Complete the First Contact Survey for all students taking the DLM. (Completed in Educator Portal).

□ Complete the Personal Needs Preference (PNP/Accommodation) for all students taking the DLM. (Completed in Educator Portal).

□ Complete a roster check to make sure all your students taking the DLM are listed for math <u>and</u> ELA. (If a student is missing make sure the box is checked on your scram and call Kira Jensen ext. 88112).

□ Make sure that the IEP is marked to take the DLM.

□ Make sure that the SCRAM has the DLM box checked. (Top right corner).

□ Email or mail completed checklist to Jen Birrell (District Office) Upon review of completed tasks, a 4-hour Re-Licensure form will be sent to you.

Required Moodle Training

Follow these steps:

- 1- Use a recommended browser to go to training.dynamiclearningmaps.org.
 - Firefox
 - Internet Explorer 11
 - Chrome
- 2- Enter your username and password
 - Username is the same email address used for Educator Portal.
 - <u>New Teachers:</u> At your first login, use your temporary password which is the first part of your email address, up to the "@."
 - For example, educator Jane Jones will use her email of <u>jjones@gmail.com</u> as her login name and a temporary password of jjones on her first login to Moodle. She will then be prompted to change her password.
 - <u>Returning Teachers:</u> Log in, click forgotten password or username if needed and follow steps.

<u>New Teachers</u> will then log out and wait for the facilitated training to take place.

<u>Returning Teachers</u> can then proceed to watch the "returning teacher Module" and complete the quiz.
