

## Depth of Knowledge: Making Your Students “Smarter than a Fifth Grader”

Depth of Knowledge (DOK) assures that your course and your assessments have rigor - and that your students gain lasting understanding. This three-hour course will teach the basics of Depth of Knowledge and give you the tools to make your curriculum more rigorous.
