

Disable Student YouTube Access

In an effort to help maintain a safe and productive digital learning environment, Information Systems has implemented a new checkbox in Skyward that provides school administrators the ability to control student access to YouTube on district Chromebooks.

This new functionality will be available within Skyward as of March 7, 2025. To access this checkbox, search for the student for which you would like to enable or disable access to YouTube. Navigate to the Student Profile → General → Web Access. Select **Edit**, check the box to **Disable YouTube**, then **Save**:
