The SRI test is now optional, and no longer has any district-prescribed testing windows. The class rosters will still be updated automatically at the beginning of each quarter. The beginning-of-year SRI upload is complete.

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SAGE Benchmarks

No testing window; always available

SAGE benchmark tests allow teachers to give brief (15-30 min) online assessments for one reporting category or standard. These test are designed to be used formatively. They are fixed-form tests, not adaptive. The questions are drawn from the SAGE Interim item bank. Student scores *and* responses will both be visible in teacher reports. The scores and reports will be accessed via AIR Ways Reporting, a new reporting tool, instead of via ORS.
