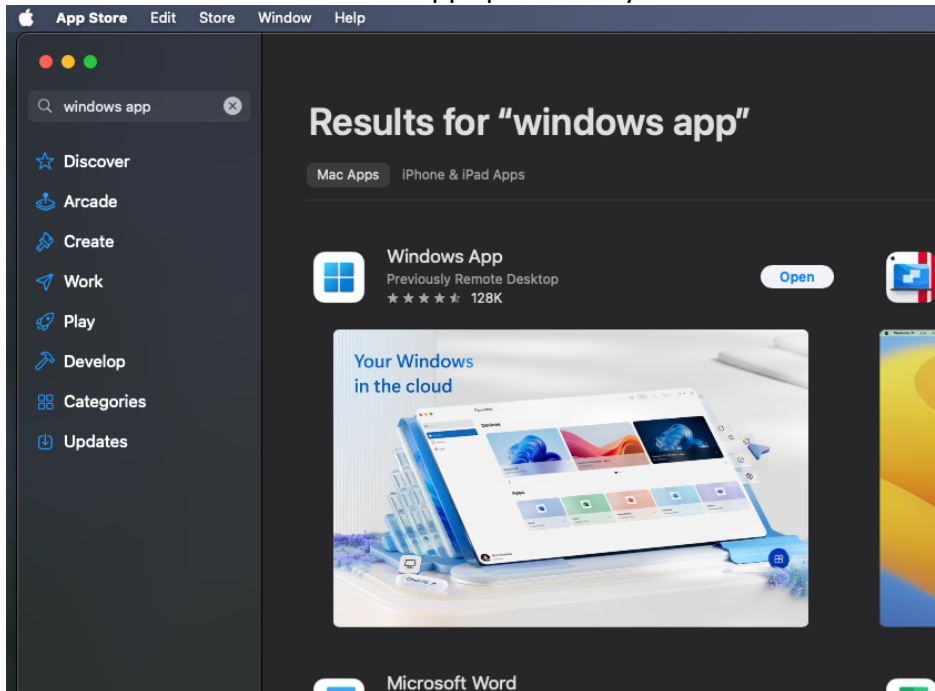
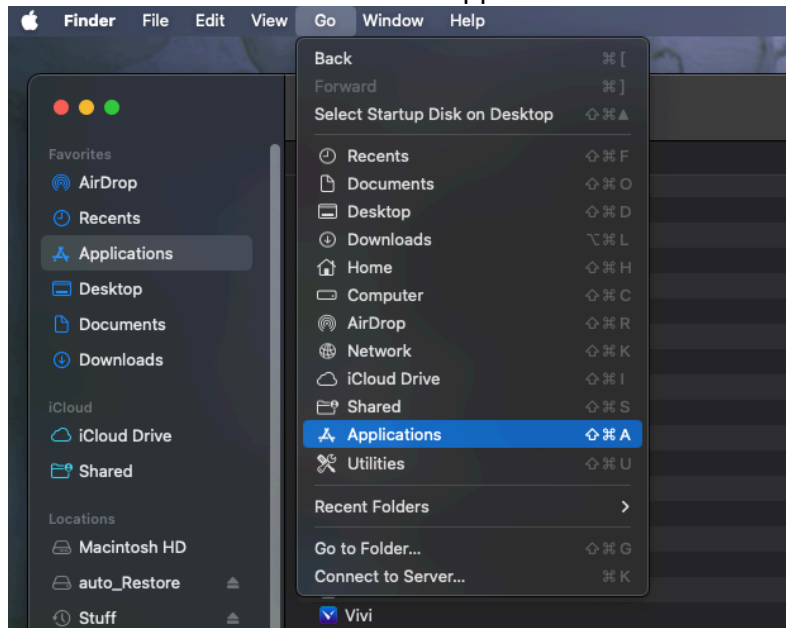


Instructions to Access Bus Video Footage from a Mac

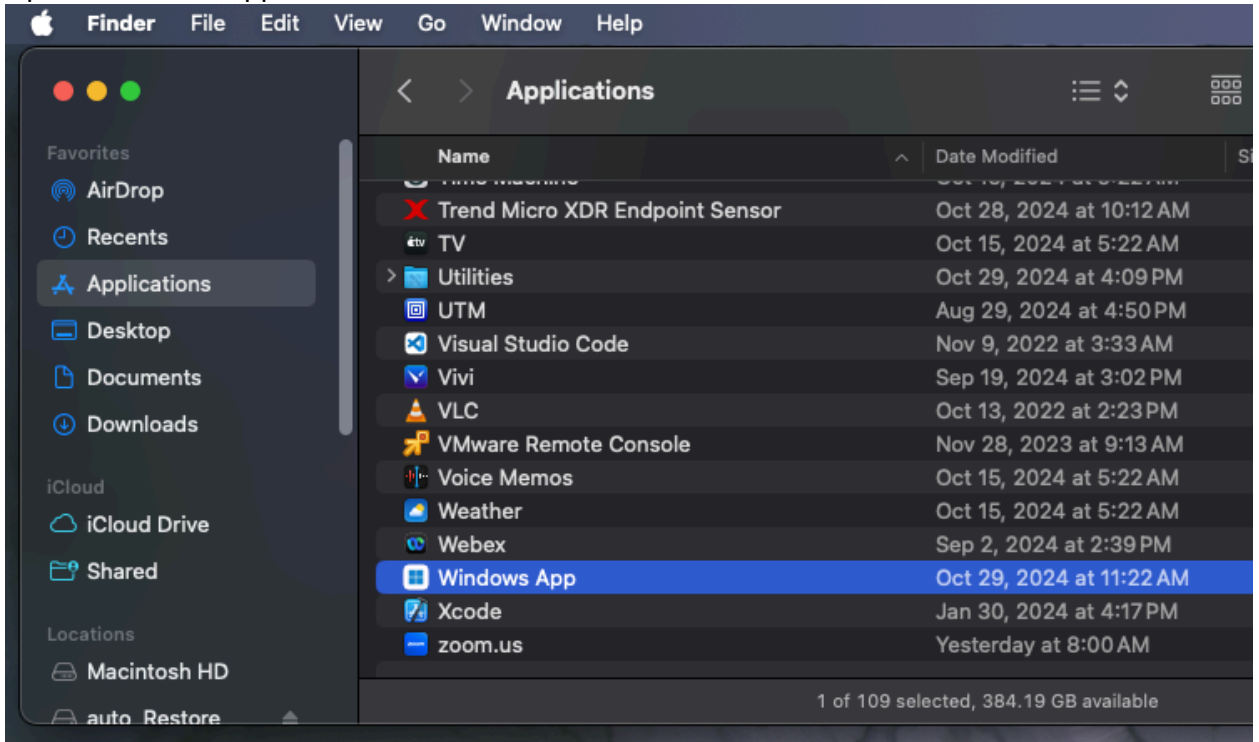
1. Obtain the “Windows App” app from the Apple App Store OR work with your district tech to have “Windows App” pushed to your Mac.



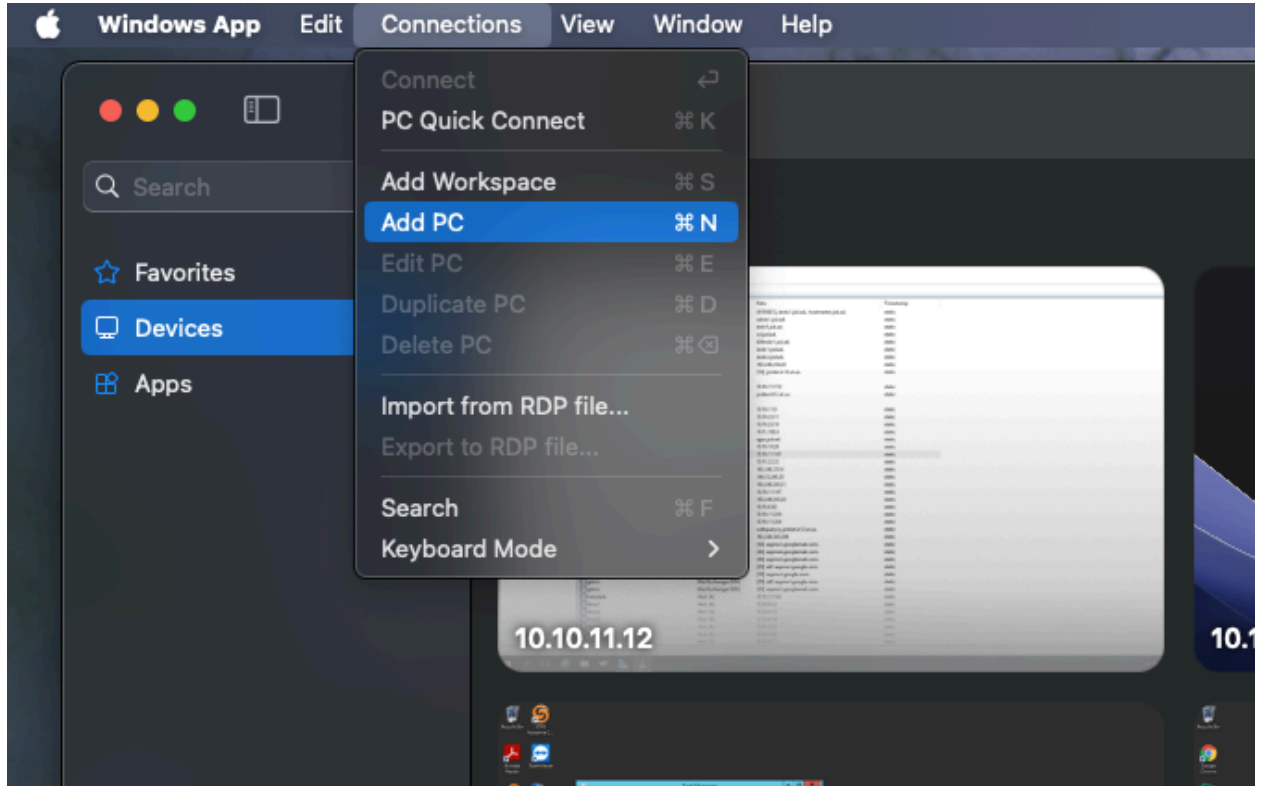
2. Open the “Windows App” app from either the app store (seen above) or from your applications folder:
 - a. Click on the desktop anywhere, or click the happy “Finder” face at the far left of your dock:
 - b. Go to the “Go” menu and select “Applications”



3. Open “Windows App”



4. Click the Add PC menu item under “Connections or under the “+” button.



5. Input the PC name: 077server.jsd.ad

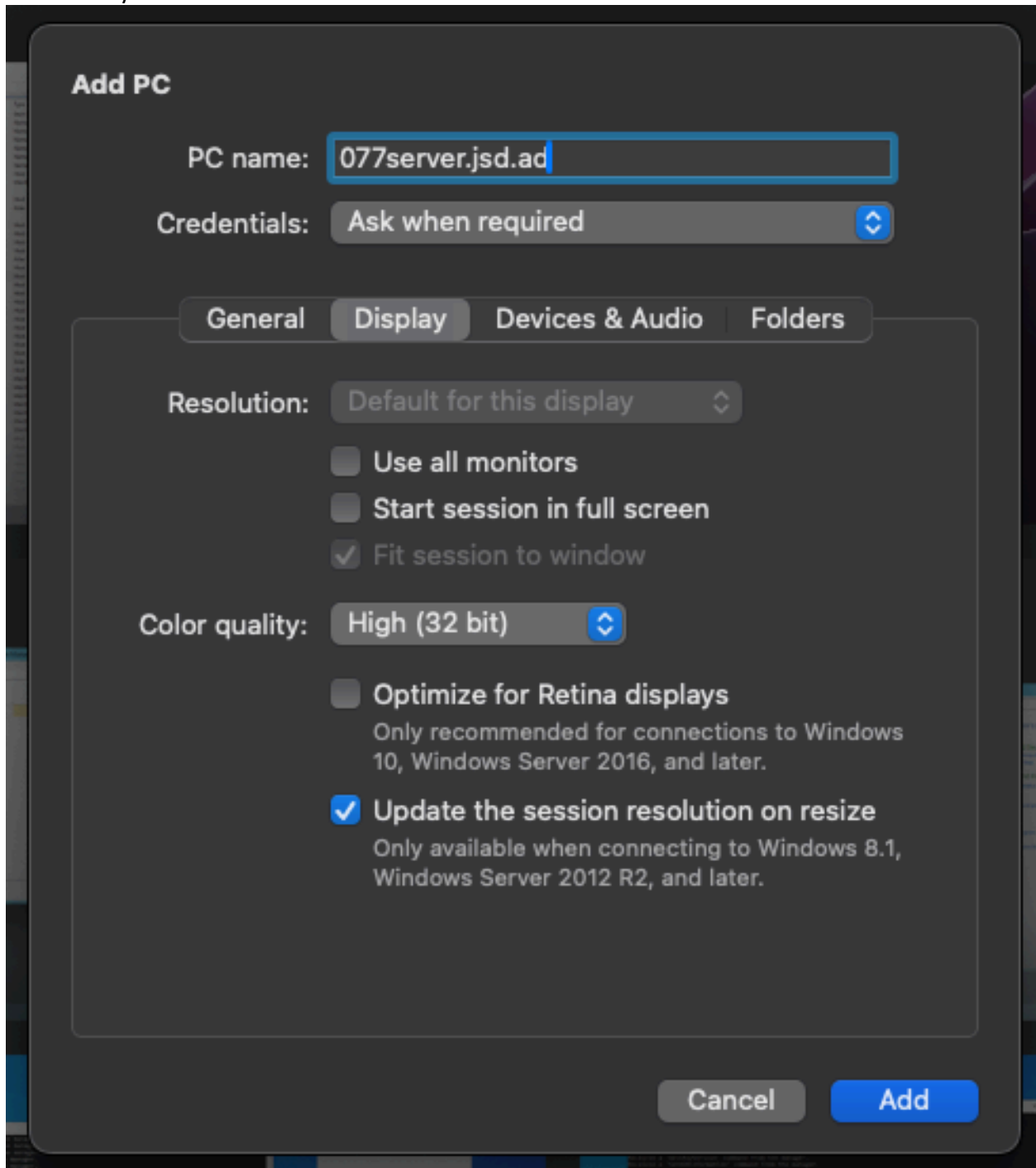

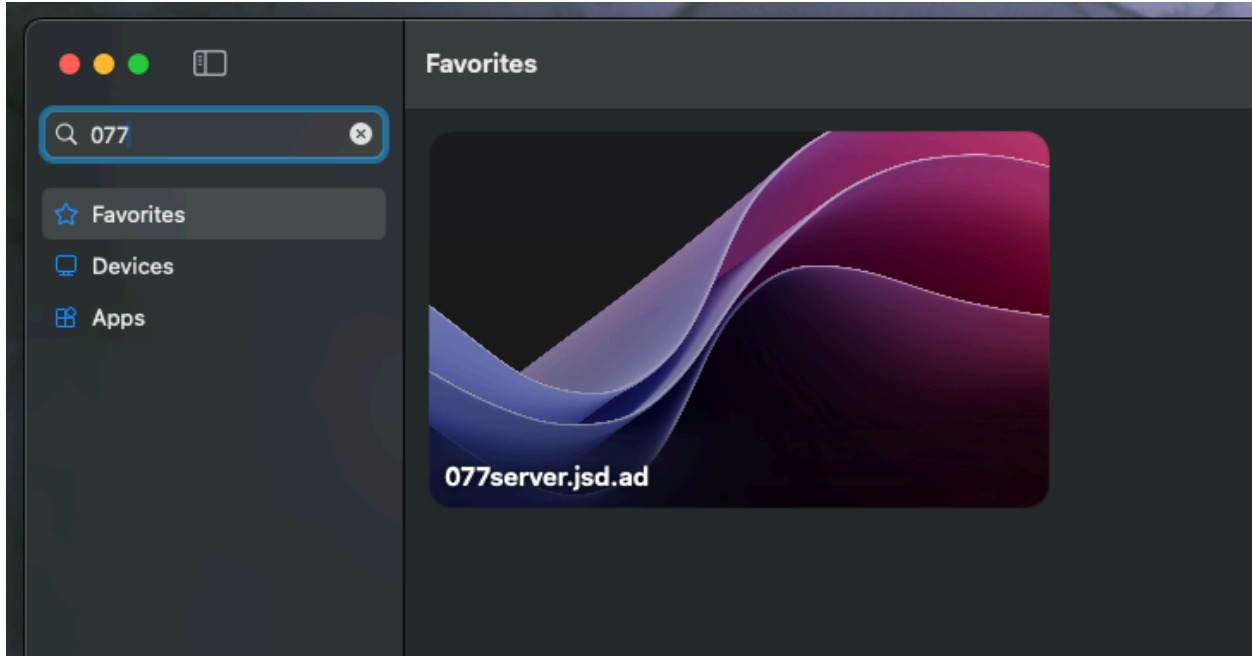
Swap mouse buttons

6. Change to the Display tab then uncheck the checkbox for “Start session in full screen” and then check the “Fit session to window”. –OPTIONAL, this step is only needed if you only want the remote server to be windowed instead of full screen.

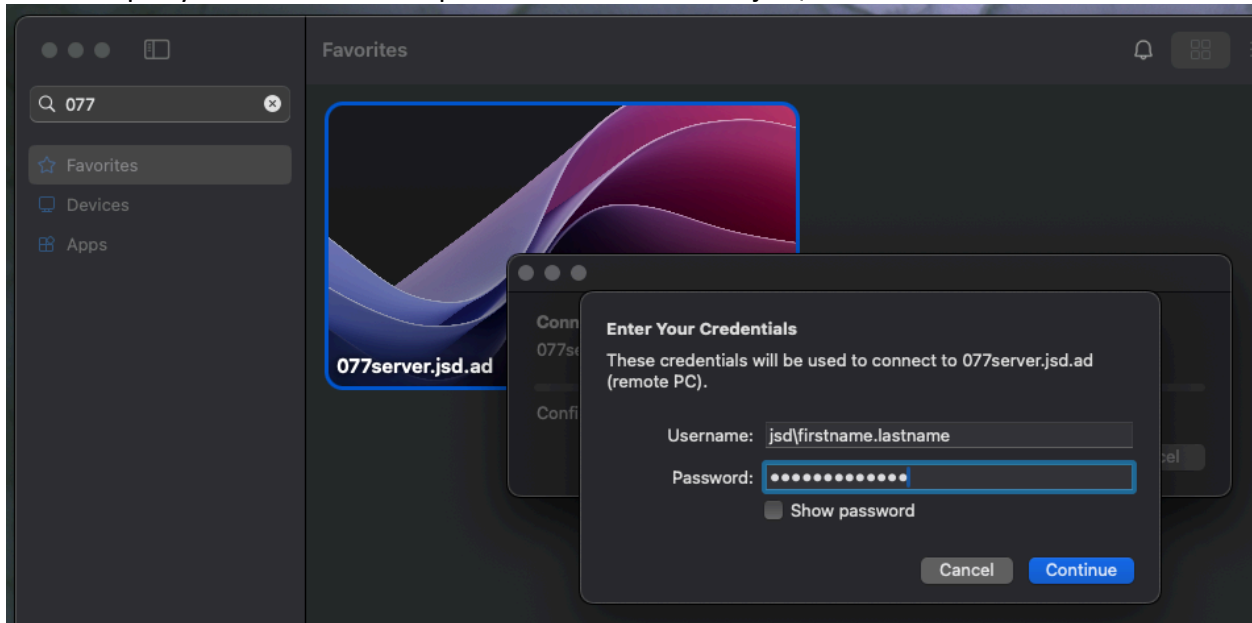


7. Click Add.

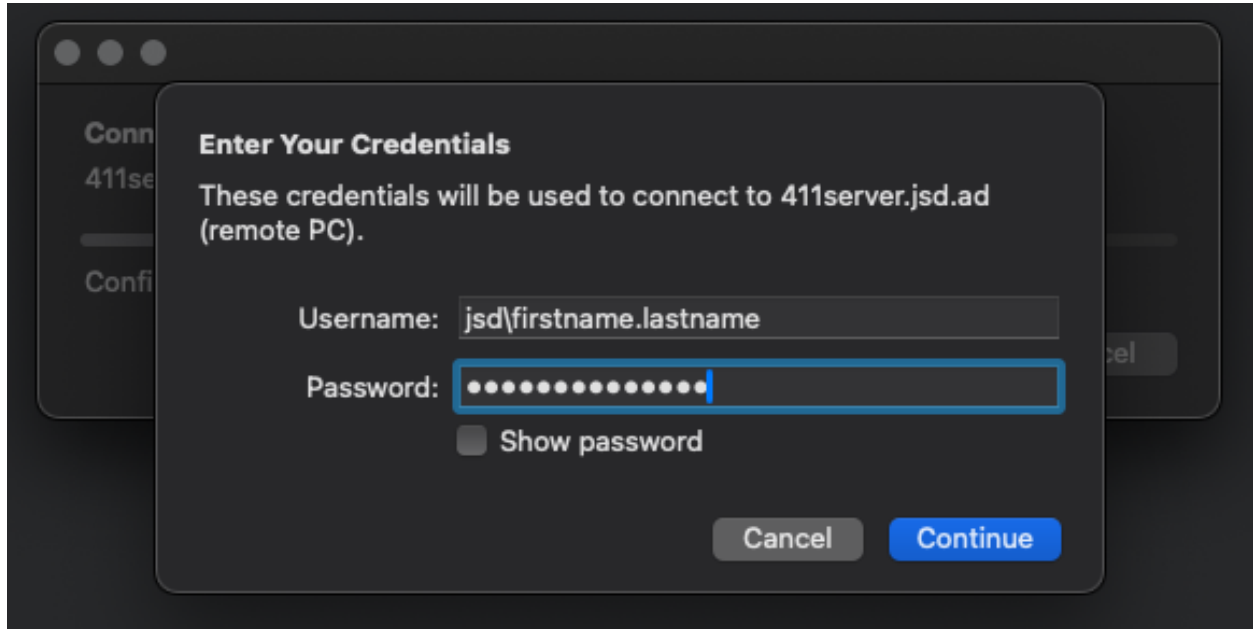
8. Double click your added PC in Microsoft Remote Desktop to connect to your remote server 077server.jsd.ad.



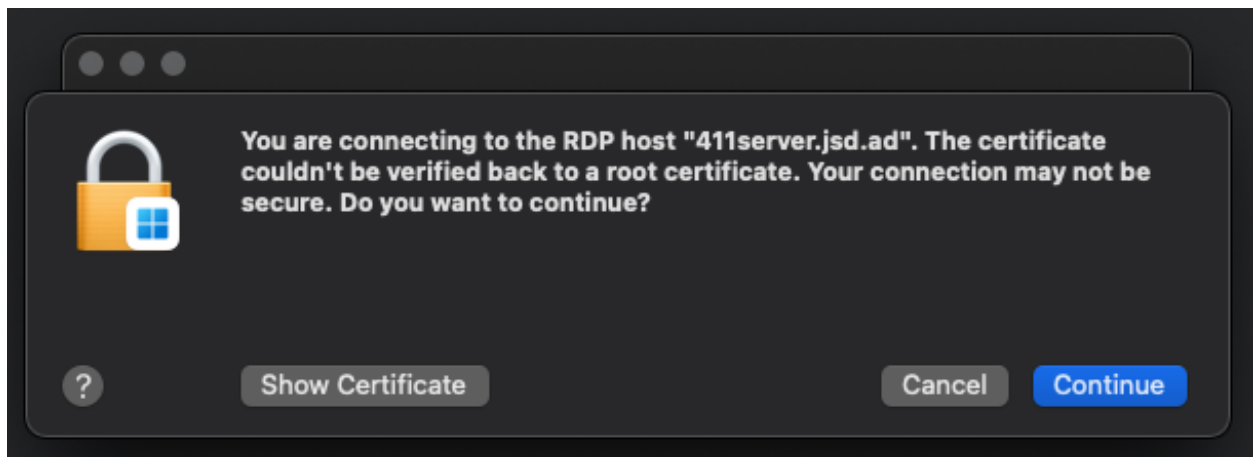
9. Input your username and password. Username is jsd\firstname.lastname



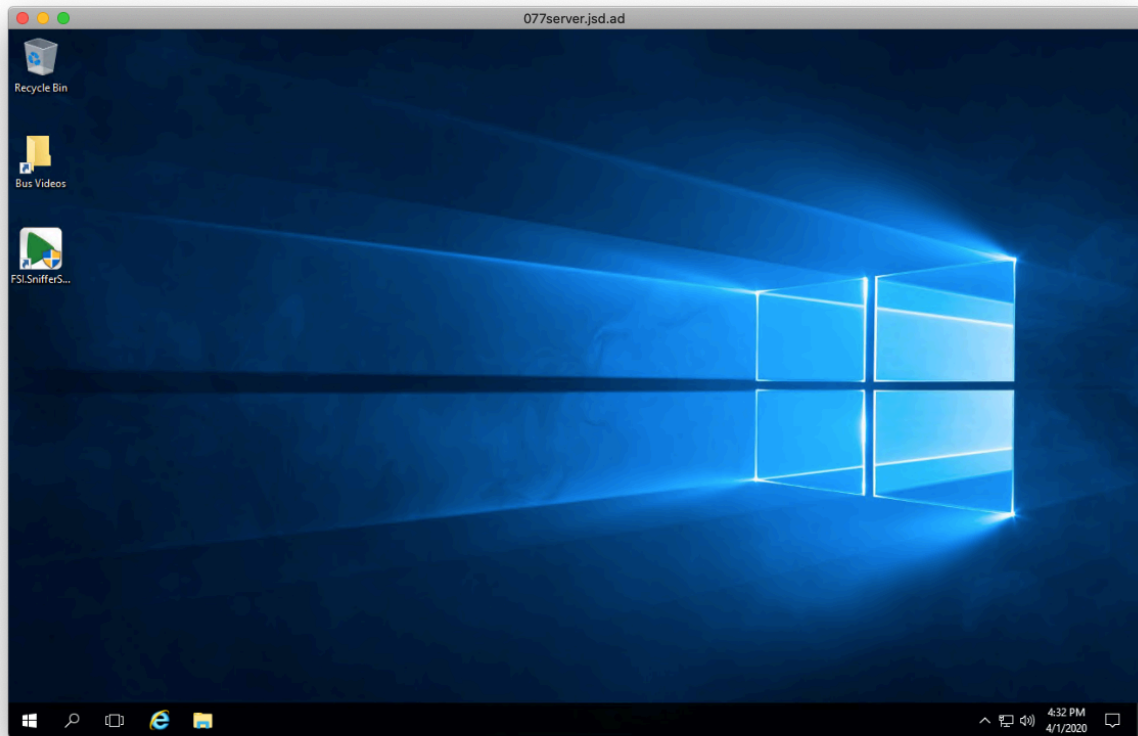
10. Click Continue.

13. While "Windows App" is open you can add it to your dock by right-clicking or ctrl-clicking and selecting options then keep in dock. -OPTIONAL
