Your school is invited to participate in Daybreak Elementary's 9^{th} Annual Math Tournament, where teams of students in grades 4-6 will compete face-to-face on Thursday, April 4, 2019. The past tournaments have been fun and rewarding for all who participated.

Attached are details and the registration form. This registration form needs to be returned to Daybreak Elementary. Priority registration is due Tuesday, December 18, 2018. All registrations received by this date will have a \$25 entry fee per team. Normal registration is due by Thursday, January 24, 2019. All registration materials received between December 18, 2018 and January 24, 2019, will have a \$30 entry fee per team. We plan to limit the tournament to 55 teams, so please let us know how many teams you would **like** to send. Priority registration will guarantee your school 2 teams. Normal registration will guarantee 1 (one) team. After the January registration deadline, you will receive further registration materials that will let you know how many teams we have accepted from your school. Registrations received after January 24 will be placed on a waiting list and accepted if space becomes available. Registrations received after January 24, 2019 will have a \$35 entry fee if accepted.

We will not require a deposit from Jordan District schools. Send no money now. We will have one payment due with the team registrations due in March. We will expect you to honor your request to participate.

Each school must send one chaperone for every 3 or 4 teams, and one additional person to help grade papers. The chaperones will proctor during the tournament. Students need to bring their own lunches and pencils. Mid-morning snacks will be provided.

Calculators will not be permitted. Every student will receive a certificate of participation, and awards will be given to high scoring individuals and teams.
