### NEW UTAH STATE ELA STANDARDS

As you may know, The P-12 Utah State
Standards for English Language Arts(ELA)
are currently being reviewed and revised.
They have not been finalized yet and are still
subject to changes. We are watching this
process carefully and will send more
information as the standards are finalized.
Here is a copy of the most recent draft:

P-12 Utah State Standards for English Language Arts.

### I'M "DONE" WITH MSRC. NOW WHAT?

95 Percent Group's MSRC (Multisyllable Routine Cards) is used to teach the 6 syllable types to students in grades 3-6. The ultimate goal is for students to apply these skills in accurately reading multisyllable words in text. The suggested instructional pacing takes about 18 weeks. Teachers should be checking for word reading skills throughout MSRC instruction. After the initial 18 weeks, teachers should still devote 5 minutes a day on these skills. Depending on students' skills, they may decide to:

- Reteach MSRC lessons whole class, focusing on multisyllable word reading. (step 3)
- Reteach MSRC lessons to targeted small groups.
- Apply knowledge of syllable types to 3-5 content vocabulary words daily.



#### 95 PERCENT GROUP

These can be used to supplement the phonics chip kit lessons in Walk to Read or to provide extra practice in classrooms or other WTR groups.



Did you know that 95 Percent Group's name relates to the research that 95% of students are cognitively capable of reading? While there is a small group of students with severe cognitive disabilities who struggle to learn to read, they are not generally found in the regular classroom. The vast majority of students are capable of learning to read with sufficient instruction. Effective tier one instruction and targeted interventions are essential to accomplishing this goal. If you have a large number of students needing intervention, strengthen tier one instruction. For students who aren't making progress in 95% skill groups, consider these questions.

### TEACHING BLENDING IN KINDERGARTEN

At this point in the school year, kindergarten students should receive phonics instruction in



blending the sounds in closed syllables (CVC words). The Teaching Blending lessons from 95% are an effective method for teaching this skill. All schools have access to these materials. Click here for more information. Blending is one of three expected outcomes for kindergarteners by the end of the year:

- 1. Know letter names and sounds to automaticity.
- 2. Segment words with 5 phonemes.
- 3. Blend CVC words with automaticity.

### GRADES 4-6 LEXIA LICENSES REMINDER

The Lexia grant is for students in grades K-3 this year. The grant is very specific; we cannot place students in grades 4-6 on Lexia through the grant, even if there are extra school licenses. At year's end, USBE will work with Lexia to determine how many licenses were used at each school. If a school chooses to place students in grades 4-6 on Lexia, they will need to purchase additional licenses for those students.
