- Select a Team Leader
- Establish Norms
- Identify PLC Team Purpose/Vision
- Review 4 Basic PLC Questions
  - What do we want students to learn?
  - How will we know when they've learned it?
  - What will we do if they learn it?
  - What will we do if they don't learn it?
- Participate in a PLC Data Cycle
  - Identify common standards
  - Unpack standards
  - Determine essential learning objectives
  - Create proficiency scales for each learning objective
  - Create common assessments for each learning objective
  - Collect assessment data
  - Analyze and compare results
  - Adjust instruction
