Optional Assessments

The SRI test is now optional except for the midyear sixth-grade placement test. The ELA benchmarks are also now optional. Since these assessments are optional, there are no district-prescribed testing windows for them.

SAGE Benchmarks

No testing window; always available

SAGE benchmark tests allow teachers to give brief (15-30 min) online assessments for one reporting category or standard. These tests are designed to be used formatively. They are fixed-form tests, not adaptive. The questions are drawn from the SAGE Interim item bank. Student scores *and* responses will both be visible in teacher reports. The scores and reports will be accessed via AIR Ways Reporting, a new reporting tool, instead of via ORS. The link to Air Ways is next to ORS on the SAGE portal landing page:

The Civics test will be given via paper and pencil/scantron again this year. The results will be recorded by each teacher in Skyward EA+ within the testing module. A nightly process will copy the information from the testing module to the educational milestone module. Office staff will also be able to enter or modify the data directly in the educational milestone module. Data for this past school year has all been loaded into the educational milestone module and is viewable in Skyward Family Access and shows on transcripts.
