All children must be assessed by the UURC to determine if they qualify for a summer program. To schedule an assessment, please go to www.uurc.utah.edu and click on "schedule an assessment". Assessment fee = \$70, separate from tuition fee. Enrollment is on a "first come - first served" basis

Early Steps

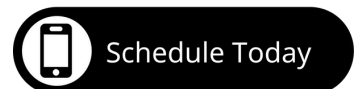
- For exiting kindergarteners / 1st graders, at-risk for reading difficulties.
- June 9 - July 17, 2025 (Monday – Thursday; no clinic on June 16th, and July 3rd)
- 9:30 a.m. - 10:15 a.m. OR 10:30 a.m. - 11:15 a.m.
- ONLINE VIA ZOOM
- Kindergartener Minimized Assessment*: \$10 non-refundable. OR G1 Full Assessment: \$70 non-refundable.
- Program Tuition: \$75 non-refundable.
- *This is a reduced assessment that determines if an exiting Kindergartener qualifies for the summer program. Formal results will not be sent to parents. Parents who want to know their student's reading, spelling, comprehension levels, etc. should schedule the full (\$70) assessment.

- For struggling students reading on a mid-grade-1 to end-grade-2 levels.
- June 12 – July 3, 2025 (Monday – Friday, no class on June 16th)

Higher Steps

- For struggling readers who can handle early-3rd grade material, but who are still below grade-level expectations.
- June 17 - July 17, 2025 (Tuesday/Wednesday/Thursday)
- 1:45 p.m. - 2:30 p.m. OR 2:45 p.m. - 3:30 p.m.

- Assessment: \$70 non-refundable.
- Program Tuition: \$75 non-refundable.



Important Contractual Obligations

I understand that if my child has more than 2 absences, UURC services will be discontinued. Connecting 5 or more minutes late for a tutoring session constitutes an absence and my child may not be tutored that day. Excessive absences may preclude your child from UURC services in the future. I understand that my child must engage in additional reading activities at home as part of intervention. These activities include reading practice and word list practice.
