SUBJECT: Policy AS90 Suspensions

District policy AS90 requires a suspension of 45 school days for students found guilty of a second offense possession or first offense distribution. As of **March 31st, 2016**, there are 45 school days remaining in the 2015-16 school year. Students in violation of this policy should be suspended for the remainder of this year. Suspended students are not allowed to participate in any school activities, including end-of-the-year events. **Seniors will not be allowed to participate in graduation ceremonies, but will be allowed to pick up their diploma the following day.**



Please inform your students' parents that 45-day suspensions after **March 31st, 2016** will carry over into the 2016-17 school year. This office will send a list to all assistant principals next Fall identifying students who have remaining days of suspension.
