

RISE Changes 2024-2025 Updates At-a-Glance



In the 2024-2025 school year, the English Language Arts (ELA) RISE assessment suite was updated to reflect the revision of the Utah State Standards for P-12 English Language Arts. These updates were applied to the RISE benchmark, interim, and summative assessments.

RISE Benchmark Assessments

- Reading and Writing Benchmarks are available for grades 3-8
 - » Cluster benchmarks available Feb 18
- 2024-2025, optional writing benchmark field test available- no automatic scoring
- 2025-2026, writing benchmarks with automatic scoring will resume

RISE Writing Summative Assessment

Required for grades 5 and 8

What has changed? -

- Summative writing prompt language
- Writing summative rubrics available at <u>utahrise.org/resources</u>
- 2025-2026, automatic scoring will resume
