

Scoring for Schools



REAL Salt Lake has partnered with Jordan Education Foundation to provide a \$250 Classroom Grant to every full-time, licensed elementary school teacher in Jordan District who applies by January 31st!

Program Guidelines

- Full-time, licensed elementary teachers, including: SLP's, art, P.E. and music may apply for up to \$250 for classroom books, materials, supplies and/or equipment. A team of grade level teachers may combine their individual allotments for a more expensive item. This grant does not apply to administrators or school psychologists.
- Materials must be acquired through Donors Choose. Teachers must complete a DonorsChoose.org project application to receive materials.
- Teachers have a very short window from January 18 – January 31, 2019 to submit their project on Donors Choose.
- Items must follow district guidelines and standards. *Items **not** eligible include: consumables (dry erase markers, paper, crayons, etc.) treats, t-shirts, salaries, honorariums, stipends, travel, field trips, & incentive awards.*
- All purchased material becomes property of the school district. If a teacher moves, the principal has discretion over items moving to a different classroom or school within the district.

The goal of **Scoring for Schools** is to give you the resources you need to equip your classrooms for a better engaged learning experience.

All projects must be loaded on Donors Choose by January 31st to be eligible.
