Some Questions you might have about the Tournament

Are Charter and Private schools allowed?

Yes. The tournament agreement is for a geographical area, not a specific type of school. Efforts are made to invite all the schools within that geographic area. All are welcome as long as they follow the rules.

Can my school bring all the teams they want?

Depends on how many you want. Every school that registers by the priority deadline will be guaranteed 2 teams. Every school that registers by the normal deadline will be guaranteed one team. We have limited space and we must consider the time needed to grade and record scores. While interest varies from year to year, we want to allow as many schools to participate as possible. Teams will be accepted depending on space available. Please request as many teams as you want to send, but have a plan in place to qualify only a limited number of teams to send if necessary.

What is the entry fee for?

The entry fee pays for the tournament agreement fee, participation awards, awards for the winners, and other expenses associated with running the tournament.

Is this a Math Olympiad?

No. The Tournament questions come from MOEMS – Math Olympiad for Elementary and Middle Schools. But this is an end of year tournament. The actual Math Olympiad is a separate program.

How do I prepare for the tournament?

You will receive problems from 2 previous years with the final registration materials in February. Use these to practice with. Learning problem solving strategies also helps.
