41,641 students, parents and educators participated in the 2024-25 Stakeholder Input Survey, which was administered in November 2024.

The Stakeholder Input Survey results have been released on Tableau. Those with Tableau accounts will be able to see aggregated responses to each of the question items that were administered to K-3, 4-6 and 7-12<sup>th</sup> grade students as well as parent and faculty responses.

As a reminder, the Stakeholder Input Survey fulfills state statute (<u>53G-11-507</u>) requiring that LEAs seek for student and parent input (and employee input for school administrators) as part of an educator evaluation program. Printed reports containing school, principal, assistant principal, and individual educator effectiveness ratings will also be distributed to principals in January 2025. Those reports will need to be distributed to educators who may choose to use those results as part of their educator evaluation. It may also be beneficial for principals to meet with individual educators to discuss their results.
