REPORT OF EMERGENCY DRILLS

Rules and regulations governing life safety in school buildings (R300.400-7) require that emergency drills be conducted during each school year.

ELEMENTARY SCHOOLS:

The first fire/evacuation drill should be completed within ten (10) days of the beginning of class.

Elementary schools are required to hold a monthly emergency drill.

A fire/evacuation drill must be conducted at least every other month.

SECONDARY SCHOOLS

A fire/evacuation drill should be completed within ten (10) days of the beginning of class and within 10 (10) days of the New Year.

The school is required to have a minimum of two (2) other safety drills during the year.

NOTE: You are also required to document this drill on your year end compliance statement.
