

The virtual Utah Science Teacher Association (UtSTA) conference starts in October. This is a great opportunity for teachers to become familiar with and expand their understanding of the new SEEd standards. Funding will need to be provided through individual school however a grant opportunity is available. You can easily apply for a grant to attend this conference. Teachers register at <u>utsta.org</u>

Below are instructions on how to register when principals are paying for multiple teachers.

- 1. Each teacher will go to <u>utsta.org</u> and click on the button to register for the conference.
- 2. If teachers are already a member they can proceed with registration.
 - When it asks for payment DO NOT PAY but print the invoice that will be sent.
 - Give the invoice to their administration.
 - Once all of the invoices are turned in, the admin will go to <u>utsta.org</u> and scroll to the
 - bottom of the home page.
 - In the donation section they will pay for the 'group' in one payment.
 - The admin MUST list the teachers names and Invoice number in the Comments Section.

If teachers are not a member they will need to pay for a membership, (or pay the nonmember price)

- Once membership is purchased go back to <u>utsta.org</u> and register for the conference.
- When it asks for payment DO NOT PAY but print the invoice that will be sent
- Give the invoice to their administration.
- Once all of the invoices are turned in the administrator will need to go to <u>utsta.org</u> and scroll to the bottom of the home page.
- In the donation section they will pay for the 'group' in one payment.
- The administrator MUST list the teachers names and Invoice number in the Comments Section.

Each teacher will need to apply for the grant individually here.
