Public Law: R277 Education, Administration R277-419-2 Definitions

R277-419 Pupil Accounting R277-419-4 Minimum School Days

"School day" means a minimum of two hours per day per session in Kindergarten and a minimum of four hours per day in grades one through twelve, subject to the requirements described in Section R277-419-4. All school day calculations shall exclude lunch periods and pass time between classes but may include recess periods that include organization or instruction from school staff.

# LAST DAY OF SCHOOL – TRADITIONAL CALENDAR

We will maintain four (4) hours of instruction for grades one through 12. Due to transportation issues on the last day of school, **a.m.** and **p.m.** sessions of kindergarten and extended-day sessions of kindergarten will <u>not</u> be in session for elementary schools on the traditional calendar. Traditional kindergarten teachers are to work the last day of school without children in their classrooms.

Dismissal time on the last day of school, **Friday**, **June 4**, **2021**, will be four (4) hours from the scheduled start of the day:

- High School Students attend virtually
- All *High Schools* will begin at their Monday-Thursday start time.
- High Schools will dismiss at 11:35 a.m.
- No busing will be provided
- Middle School Students attend virtually
- All *Middle Schools* will begin at their Monday-Thursday start time.
- *Middle Schools* will dismiss at 11:30 a.m., 11:50 a.m. or 12:00 p.m., depending upon start time.
- No busing will be provided
- *Elementary Students* Grades 1-6 will attend in-person.
- *Elementary Schools* will dismiss four (4) hours after their regular scheduled start time.
- Kindergarten (a.m. and p.m. sessions) will not be in session on Friday, June 4.
- *Kindergarten teachers* are to work the last day of school without children in their classrooms.
- Busing will be provided
- Kauri Sue Hamilton School attend virtually

Will dismiss four (4) hours after their regular scheduled start times.

#### LAST DAY OF SCHOOL – YEAR-ROUND CALENDAR

We will maintain four (4) hours of instruction for Grades one through 6. Tracks A, B, C, & D a.m. and p.m. sessions of kindergarten will not be in session on the last day of school at South Jordan Elementary. Year-round kindergarten teachers are to work the last day of school without children in their classrooms. Elementary students will attend the last day in-person.

#### Track A

The last day for students on Track A (grades 1-6) will be Friday, June 11, 2021. Track A students will attend school in-person from 8:30 a.m. - 12:30 p.m. Kindergarten (a.m. and p.m. sessions) will not be in session on Friday, June 11. Kindergarten teachers are to work the last day of school without children in their classrooms. School lunch will not be served on Friday, June 11 for Track A. Transportation will run double runs in order to take A track students home at their 12:30 p.m. dismissal time.

## Tracks B, C, and D

The last day for Tracks B, C, and D (grades 1-6) will be Friday, July 2, 2021. Grades 1-6 will attend in person from 8:30 - 12:30 p.m. Kindergarten (a.m. and p.m. sessions) will not be in session on Friday, July 2. Kindergarten teachers are to work the last day of school without children in their classrooms.

Note: Breakfast will be served if the site normally serves breakfast. School lunch will not be served on the last day of school for tracks B, C, & D.
