SUBJECT: Utah Aspire Plus OnDemand Reports

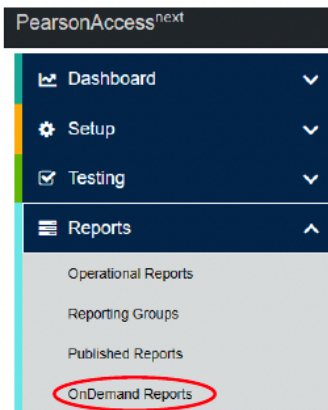
School administrators are encouraged to pass the following information on to their 9th or 10th grade ELA, math, and science teachers.

For the first time, student detail reports will be available within 24 hours after the student submits any of the Utah Aspire Plus subtests. The purpose of the student detail reports is to provide student performance data to teachers for each subtest (English, reading, math and science) prior to the release of the individual student reports, which provides a composite score for all four subtests. Student detail reports may be access in PearsonAccessNext under OnDemand Reports.

Please note that all other reports, including overall subject area, grade level or school level reports, will be released later this summer.

1. From Reports, select OnDemand Reports.



2. Type student names into the search field and click Search.

- You can also filter by Student Name or SSID, Subject Name, Grade, or Proficiency Level to help you locate the report for specific students.
- Select certain students by clicking on blue information icon or to print all reports select Download and then Student Detail Report (pdf). Administrators can also download the list view that is shown on the screen by selecting the Student List Report.
